- The CNC / NFCC partnership enables NFCC families to improve their health and nutrition while experiencing a more balanced meal.-

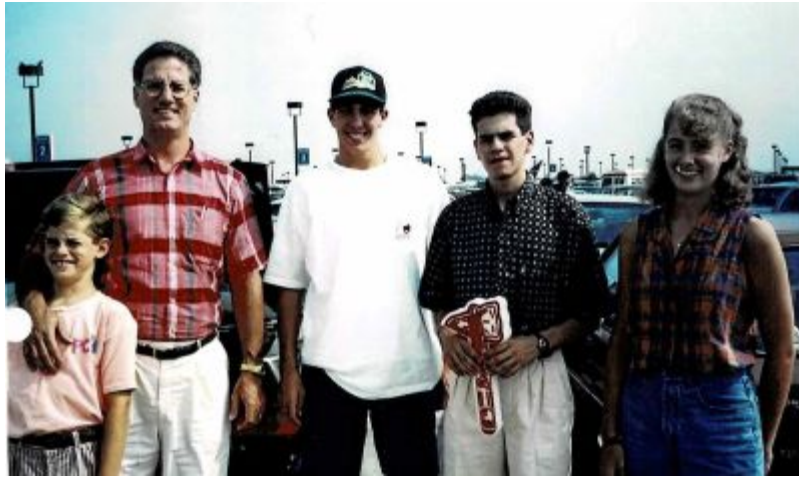
-For the past 12 years, CNC's Unity Garden has supplied more than 32 tons of fresh produce to the clients of NFCC

Injury and Surgery Play a Small Part in the Need for Blood

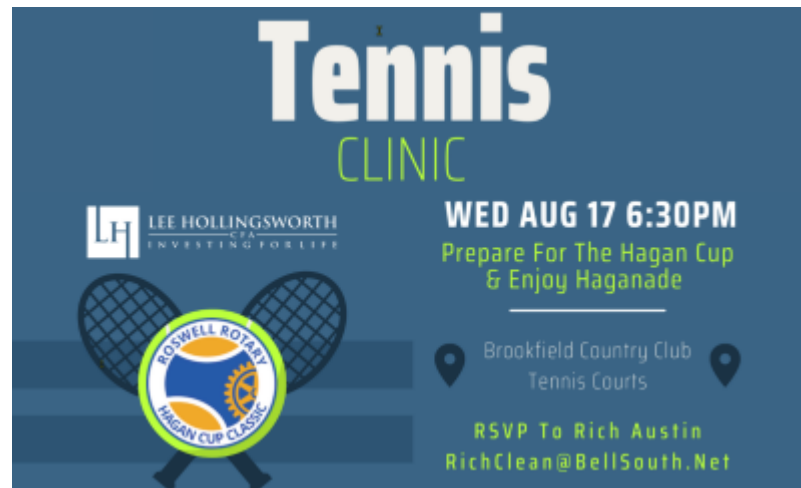
