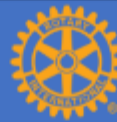

Back to School Pajama Drive for Star House



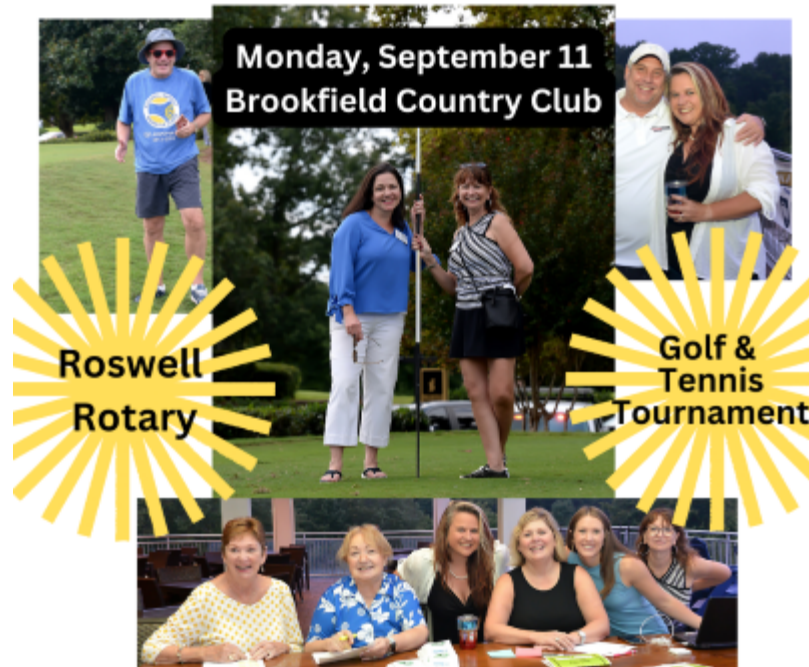
